## **LESSON PLAN**

## WORD STRESSING

**<u>Aims</u>**: words carry important information

**Skills practised / needed:** speaking

**Props:** a sentence with different word stressed each time

## **How to play:**

Sentence stress is the pattern of <u>stressed and unstressed</u> words across a sentence. Normally this emphasis is **on words that carry important information**, although this can change significantly, depending on the specific meaning the speaker wants to communicate.

A neighbor's cat overturned flowers in front of the house again yesterday.

A neighbor's **cat** overturned flowers in front of the house again yesterday.

A neighbor's cat **overturned** flowers in front of the house again yesterday.
